ADDENDUM TO THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION FOR THE CHIDITAROD FOUNDATION

Article IV

The purposes of The Chiditarod Foundation ("Foundation") are:

The Foundation is organized and shall be operated exclusively for charitable, scientific, and educational purposes, all for the public welfare, within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

In particular, the Foundation is organized to solicit, accept, hold, administer, invest and disburse such property and funds as may from time to time be contributed to the Foundation for charitable, scientific and educational purposes, including for such purposes as the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) and the operation of such other programs as determined by the Foundation's Board of Directors, pursuant to guidelines approved by the Internal Revenue Service.

Among the specific activities and undertakings of the Foundation is the following: to raise and expend property and funds for the purposes of: 1) combating hunger in Illinois; 2) financing and sponsoring, publishing, promoting and distributing research on issues important to combating hunger in Illinois; 3) providing educational programs that facilitate the discussion and debate of policy or operational matters that impact hunger in Illinois; and 4) sponsoring activities and projects that are consistent with the stated purposes within this Article IV.

Article V

Other provisions:

- (A) In no event shall any part of the net earnings of the Foundation inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its Directors or officers or to other private persons, except that the Foundation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in these Articles.
- (B) No substantial part of the activities of the Foundation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Foundation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.
- (C) Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the Foundation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on: (i) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code; or (ii) by a corporation, contributions to which are

- deductible under Section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
- (D) Upon the dissolution of the Foundation, the assets of the Foundation shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.
